

Guide for Filling Out an Italian National Visa Application

Updated October 2023

Note: Please make sure your information fits in the respective boxes. We recommend writing small and as clearly as possible!

1. Last Name
2. Put N/A if you have never changed your last name
3. First Name
4. Write DAY, MONTH, then YEAR
5. City you were born in
6. Country you were born in
7. USA if you're currently a US citizen
8. Select male or female
9. Select marital status
10. N/A unless you are a minor
11. Select Ordinary Passport
12. Enter your passport number
13. Enter the issue date on passport (DAY/MONTH/YEAR)
14. Enter the expiration date on passport (DAY/MONTH/YEAR)
15. US Dept of State (or respective issuer)
16. Your permanent address or local address and email address; enter phone number in second box
17. Select "No" unless you are not a US citizen
18. Enter "Student"
19. Enter UMD's address:

20. Select "Study"
21. Write the city you are studying abroad in
22. Write the name of first country you will land in the Schengen Zone (see the end of this document for a list of Schengen countries)
 - a. If you have a layover in a Schengen country before arriving in Italy, put that country down.
23. Select "Multiple Entries"
24. Enter the total number of days of your program (NOT how long you intend to stay in Italy with any personal travel)
25. Enter the day you first arrive in the Schengen zone, including any layovers (DAY/MONTH/YEAR)
26. N/A for all three boxes
27. Contact information for programs. **FILL OUT ALL THREE BOXES.** For Maryland-in programs, it's as follows:

BE SURE TO SIGN AND DATE IN PEN AT THE BOTTOM OF THE THIRD PAGE AS WELL.

SCHENGEN AREA COUNTRIES

The 1985 Schengen Agreement established a uniform customs method for member countries. Currently, all EU countries are members of the Schengen area with the exception of Bulgaria, Ireland, Romania and the UK. In addition, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway and Switzerland are members of the Schengen area (but not of the EU). The Schengen agreement makes travelling through member countries very easy. Your passport may not be stamped or even checked when crossing borders in the Schengen Area.
