

You will be required to order a transcript from your USAC sponsoring institution and have it sent to Education Abroad in order for your transfer credits to be evaluated and applied to your UMD degree. Information on this process will be available for you in your USAC Gateway Account under "Credit Transfer Instructions." If enrolled in only courses approved as resident credit, an official transcript is not required.
